Type Tools

Use the Type, Area Type and Path Type tools. Type the following phrase using each of the type tools listed. Set the type in 18 point Futura Book and use 22 point leading where applicable. Label each example with the name of the type tool used. Print B+W. Save file to Project 4 CD.

Embedding vs Linking

Go to www.internationalposter.com/access.cfm and download two images. Place each image on a separate layer in the same Illustrator file. Link one of the images and embed the other. Include a text description for each image that provides the artist's name, the dimensions of the artwork and the year it was created. Save file to Project 5 CD.

Book Jacket

Create a book jacket (cover, back and flaps) for your own autobiography. Research the meaning of your first name and/or last name. Create the front cover composition with the letters of your name that interprets the meaning. Consider the standard book jacket conventions for designing the rest of the jacket. Choose an actual book to define dimensions of the book jacket. Print in color, trim, put on book, and turn in. Save file as PDF for screen viewing on the web. Include file on Project 5 CD.
