Technology Objectives

1. Learn to use scan.

3. Learn to color correct an image

Photoshop 7 Savvy

Read the chapters 14-19 and complete Hands On 5, 6 and 7. When completed, save the files to Project 8 CD.

Scanned Image 1

Bring a photo to class on Wednesday. Be sure photo has an object in the foreground. Scan the photo using three different resolutions in RGB mode: 72 ppi, 150 ppi and 300 ppi. Convert scans to CMYK mode. Resize photographs to 5x7". Print out the scans and label the resolution. Print black and white copies label with ppi. Save images to Project 9 CD

Colorize Grayscale Image

Using pixel editing tools, selections, layers and blend mode, colorize the B+W.psd. Download image from class website. Print color version.
