Once you have received this form, you must submit payment (as described on the approval form) to the Water Authority before the tap(s) and/or water meter(s) are installed. In addition, a “Customer Application and Service Agreement” must be executed by both the Owner and Water Authority before continuous service is provided. This form is only available at the offices of the Water Authority located at 8955 Gaylord Drive, Houston, Texas 77024. You must have a permit from the City having jurisdiction before connecting to any service installed by the Water Authority.
